Subject: Temporary Close of Navanakorn Branch due to Flooding

Big C Supercenter Public Company Limited (the "Company") would like to inform that since there has been flooding in some area of Big C, Navanakorn branch and power supply has been cut since the night of 18 October 2011. The Company has necessity to temporarily close the Navanakorn branch from 19 October 2011 onwards until the situation will be back to normal.

The Navanakorn branch is only one hypermarket of the Company which has been closed due to the flooding. For Mini Big C, there are 4 branches which have been closed temporarily due to the flooding i.e. Luan Phung 5 branch (Ladkrabang district), Navanakorn branch, Soi Khunpra (Amphur Klongluang) and Rattanakosin (Amphur Thanyaburi).

However, the Company has prepared the contingency plans to deal with flooding situation and taken out insurance covering flood/water damage to the property including business interruption.
